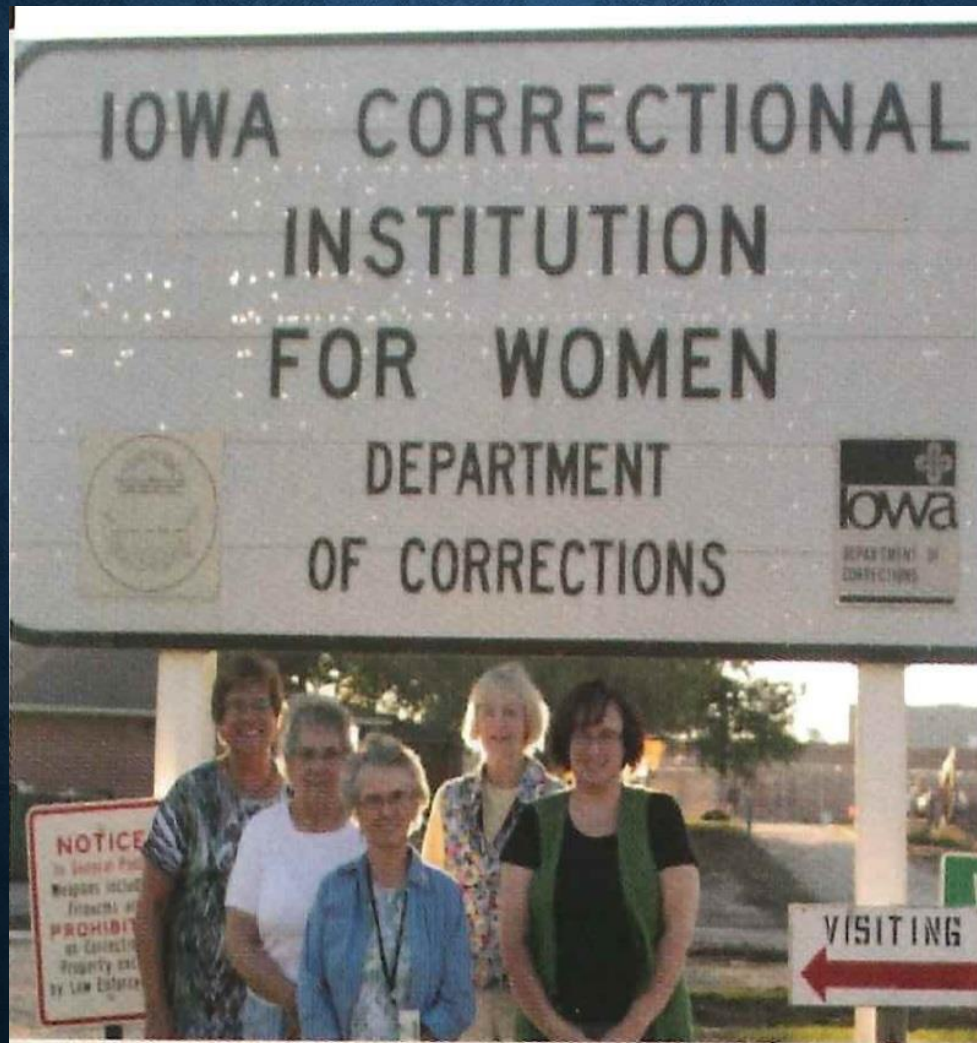

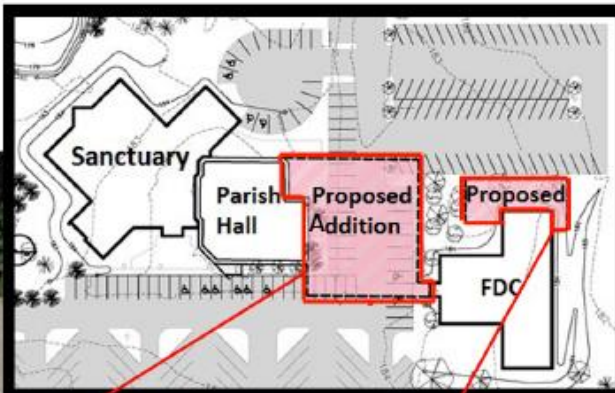
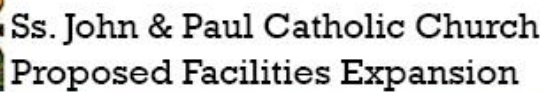


KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS FISH FRIES

Aerial View - Site Plan

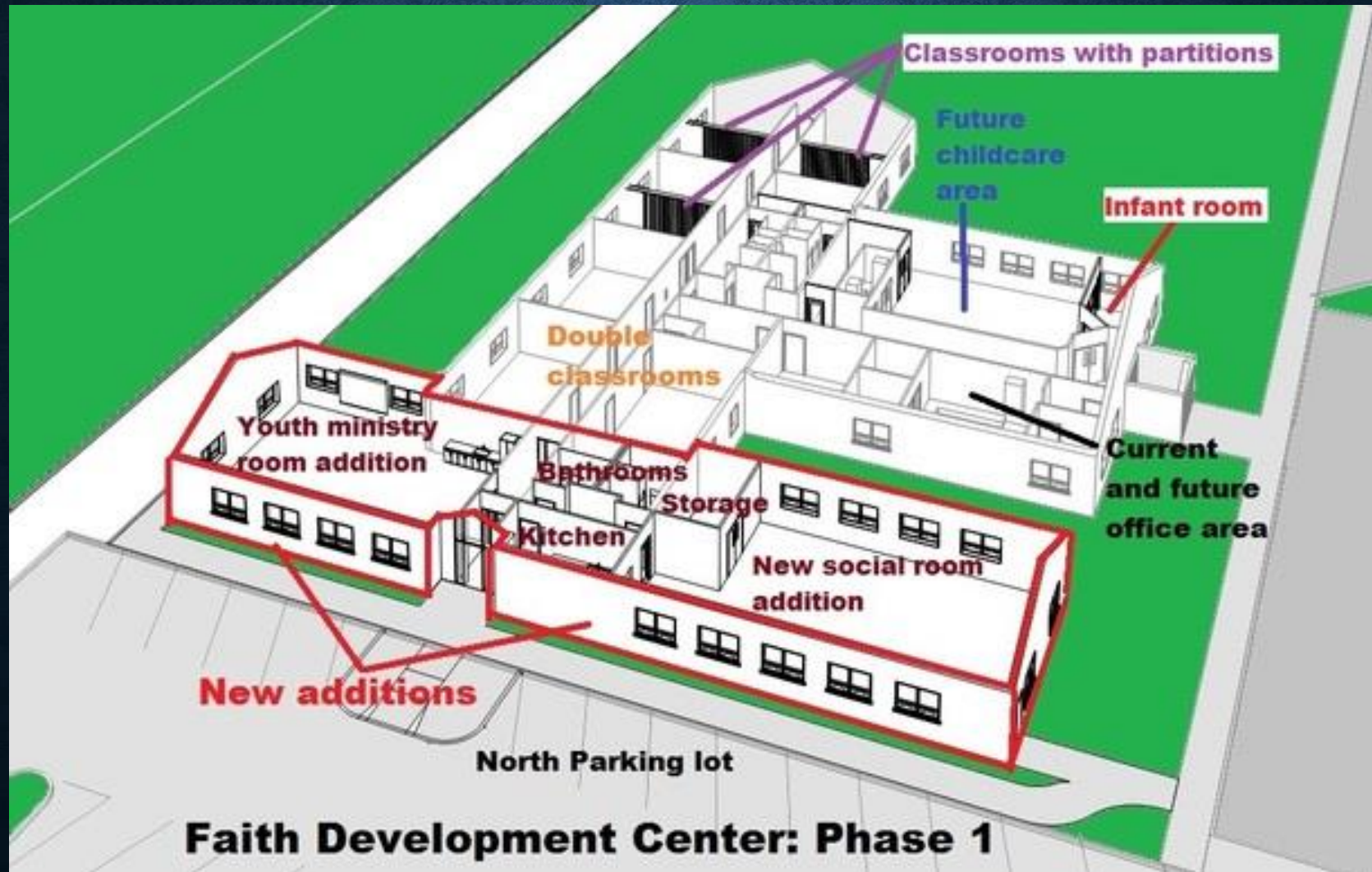

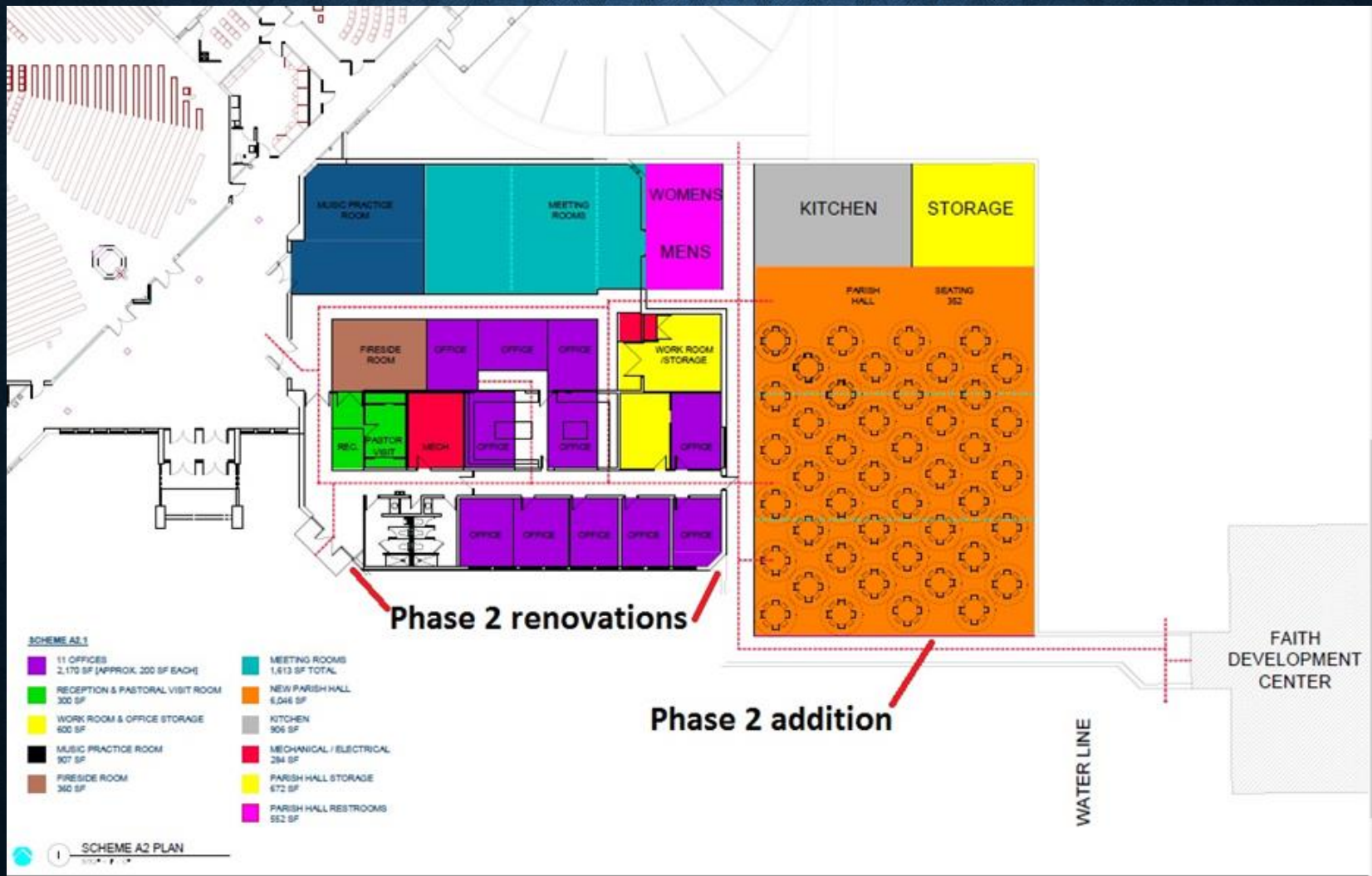
